



RESTRICTION EXEMPTION PROGRAM

The Canadian School of Hydrocarbon Measurement will be following government mandates and is working with the Calgary Telus Convention Centre (CTCC) to comply with the Restriction Exemption Program.

All attendees, exhibitors and sponsors will be required to comply with the Restriction Exemption Program. At the present time the CTCC has released the following document, the CsHm will update our COVID-19 information should anything change.

With the safety and health of visitors and staff as our top priority, effective Monday September 20, the Calgary TELUS Convention Centre is participating in the Restriction Exemption Program as outlined by the City of Calgary and Government of Alberta.

When attending events at CTCC, people 12 years and older will be required to present proof of vaccination, a negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours of the event, or a medical exemption letter, along with personal identification, to be granted access to events at the Centre.

Proof of Vaccination

Your proof of vaccination must display the name, type of vaccine and the date it was received. This should be the COVID-19 QR record printed or shown on an electronic device from:

- Alberta Health Services
- A First Nation
- Another province or territory
- Canadian armed forces



RESTRICTION EXEMPTION PROGRAM

Proof of Negative Test Result

You can show a COVID-19 negative test result. Tests must be:

- Provided as an original or printed copy (photos are not sufficient)
- Privately-paid
- A Health Canada approved rapid antigen, rapid PCR or lab-based PCR test
- Completed within the past 72 hours

Test results must show the type of test, time of sample collection, clear indication of a negative result, and laboratory that completed the test. Tests must not be from Alberta Health Services or Alberta Precision Laboratories.

Medical Exemption Letter

You must show an original signed letter from a physician or nurse practitioner that includes:

- Your name that matches your identification (only required for adults 18 and over)
- Physician's or nurse practitioner's complete information, including their name, phone number, contact information, professional registration number and signature
- A statement that there is a medical reason for not being fully vaccinated against COVID-19
- The duration that the exemption is valid

Vaccine Dosage Requirements

Proof of double vaccination (or single Janssen dose) with the final dose administered at least 14 days prior to entry is required for all customers 12 years and older to access all events at the Centre.

Accepted Forms of Personal Identification

- Birth certificate issued by a government of a province of Canada
- Citizenship card
- Driver's license issued by a government of a province of Canada
- Government (Alberta or other) issued identification card, including health card
- Certificate of Indian status
- Métis Nation of Alberta Association citizenship and identification card
- Inuit Status card
- Passport attesting to citizenship or other national status, issued by a government of any jurisdiction
- Permanent Resident Card
- Any other form of identification recognized by the Chief Medical Officer of Health
